- II. After review, the April 2026 Board Meeting minutes were unanimously approved. Motion by Katie, second by Dana, none in opposition
- III. School Board President's Report: (Katie Tinley)
1. Katie is chairing her final Board meeting as the second Board term expirations were announced for Katie and Therese
 2. A nomination was made to add Debbie Morales to the Board with a formal vote to be made at the next meeting
 3. Nominations were made for the 2026-27 school year Board positions:
 - a. President – Brad Abbey
 - b. Treasurer – Marco Mendoza
 - c. Secretary – Debbie Morales (if voted onto the Board)

- IV. Treasurer's Report: (Marco Mendoza)
 - 1. The budget for the 2026-27 school year was discussed and voted in at the last Board Finance Committee meeting. The committee recommended approval of the budget to the Board
- V. Secretary's Report: (Brad Abbey)
 - 1. The first Board term expirations were announced for Marco and Ronnie. Their second terms will start July 1, 2026
- VI. Disciplinary Committee's Report: (Katie Tinley in Liezette Felicione's absence)
 - 1. No new business
- VII. Parental Involvement Representative (Yvette Gonzalez)
 - 1. No new business
- VIII. CEO Report: (Joe Sansonetti)
 - 1. Presented the budget for the 2026-27 school year that was previously approved by the Board Finance Committee. Following presentation and discussion, the budget was unanimously approved. Motion by Marco, second by Celeste, none in opposition
 - 2. Of significant importance to the administration is the upcoming charter renewal process which will begin in 2027
- IX. Development (Nicole Morgado)
 - 1. The 2026-27 school year calendar was revised to comply with the new Veteran's Day statute
 - 2. The PPA was praised for their fundraising success during the 2025-26 school year. Highlights included \$146K raised from the Annual Fund, \$106K raised from the school supply service, \$60K raised from Read-a-thon, \$14K raised from Spirit Week, and \$13K raised from the Holiday Shop
 - 3. A new fundraising event was announced for September 26, 2026. Trinity is partnering with Hillsborough County Fire Rescue to host a pro wrestling event in the Athletic & Arts Center. Fundraising packages and tickets will be available for purchase
- X. Principal's Report: (Jennifer Cisneros)
 - 1. The school's mental health and reading plans, which were approved at the April Board meeting, are ready for submission

2. The final copy of the annual site visit report from Hillsborough County Public Schools was distributed. The draft copy was distributed at the April Board meeting
3. Four Kindergarten orientations have been conducted so far this summer for new school families
4. Provided an update on staff vacancies and new hires
5. A new elective wheel is being worked on with the goal of offering 7 elective classes to the 5th-8th grade students
6. Recapped the successful end-of-year events that were held at the Straz Center including Academic Awards, Athletic Awards, and 8th Grade Graduation
7. The annual Meet & Greet program is scheduled for August 7, 2026

XI. Early Childhood Report: (Nicole Morgado in Dr. Kris Bennet's absence)

1. The theme for EC summer programming is Little Explorers
2. The students are enjoying the use of the new Athletic & Arts Center
3. Upcoming summer events include a foam party, dog show, kindergarten boot camp, and graduation
4. Associate training is planned for July and there is currently one teacher vacancy
5. 42 families who have never attended Trinity are signed up for New Parent Orientation

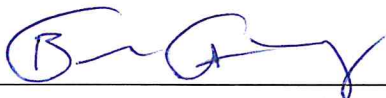
